

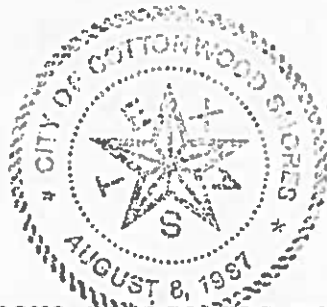
PUBLIC HEARING

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The City of Cottonwood Shores Commissioners convened in a Public Hearing at the P.O.A. Clubhouse August 16, 1990 at 7.00 p.m.. Those present were Leon Upshaw, Mayor; Adrian Gawlik, Commissioner 1; and Mike Butler, Commissioner 11.

PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Cottonwood Shores convened into the Public Hearing to review their performance of the Planning and Capacity Building Grant as financed through the Texas Department of Commerce.

Leon Uphsaw opened the hearing with prayer. He then asked for comment from any citizen present on the performance of the contract or any technical questions of any phase of the study.

Gandolf Burrus spoke on the city having this final close out hearing of the Planning and Capacity Building Grant which the city was fully funded for. He commended Willis Environmental Engineers for successfully completing the contract.

Bill Hennesy asked if the water lines that exist in our city now and the lines planned for in the Water Study would be able to produce water pressure for filling up the fire trucks without damaging the lines. Tony Plumlee explained that the existing water lines in Cottonwood Shores are between 2" and 4" with the 4" lines along Cottonwood Drive and down Pecan Street and they could not handle filling two fire rigs up at high pressure. The proposed study is designed for population, usage and fire protection with 8" mains to replace the 4" as well 6" lines in other areas. Tony felt that this system would handle emergencies such as the one Bill was asking about. Bill was satisfied with the answer.

As there were no other questions, Gandolf Burrus thanked the city secretary for her part in the successful completion of the grant and Leon Upshaw for carrying the grant to completion after the untimely death of the former Mayor, Dutch Leming.

Meeting was adjourned at 7.37 p.m..


