

**MINUTES OF A

1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL:** Mayor Pickens called this Special Meeting to Order at 6:04 p.m. with both Commissioner Phipps and Commissioner Pfeifer in attendance, a Quorum was present.
2. **CONSIDER AND POSSIBLY TAKE ACTION ON A REQUEST BY MS. LINDA BENNISON FOR A VARIANCE TO ORDINANCE NO 031899 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS PROVIDING RULES, REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR WATER, WASTEWATER AND SOLID WASTE SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY:** Mayor Pickens explained the Council had declined this request at the Regular Meeting. No action was taken at that time. Commissioner Pfeifer made a motion to not approve the request for a variance by Ms. Bennison. Commissioner Phipps seconded the motion, which carried.
3. **CONSIDER AND POSSIBLY TAKE ACTION ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF RELEASES FOR THE CITY FROM MS. DOTTIE STUECKROTH AND EAST TEXAS SIGN COMPANY AND ISSUANCE OF A SIGN PERMIT AS REQUESTED BY MS. DOTTIE STUECKROTH AND EAST TEXAS SIGN COMPANY:** Mayor Pickens stated through correspondence the Council would provide Ms. Stueckroth a permit for a sign on her property in exchange for the releases from her and East Texas Sign Company. Commissioner Pfeifer made a motion to accept the releases from Ms. Stueckroth and East Texas Sign Company in exchange for a permit. Commissioner Phipps seconded the motion, which carried.
4. **CONSIDER AND POSSIBLY TAKE ACTION ON A REQUEST BY MR. FRANK SMITH TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE LAKEVIEW DRIVE FOR THE 7<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL EASTER EGG HUNT AND COMMUNITY PICNIC:** Mayor Pickens explained parking area was limited this year due to the street work on Lakeview Drive. He suggested making Lakeview Drive one way for east bound traffic from Pecan Lane to Driftwood Lane. Westbound traffic could exit out Driftwood Lane. The City could provide one officer to assist with traffic control. He suggested posting signs on Brookwood to inform public of the changes. Linda Smith stated she thought that was a good idea. Commissioner Pfeifer added parking should be on the north side of Lakeview in order to keep the eastbound lane open. Mayor Pickens stated the number of people who attend is growing. He added help is needed to control traffic in order to avoid any accidents. He asked if Frank Smith knew of any volunteers to help. Frank asked how many were needed. Mayor Pickens stated that would depend on how long each shift would be. He noted the City could provide reflective safety vest for the volunteers to wear. He added now we need signs and barricades to direct traffic. He asked Frank to check with the county about borrowing detour signs for the day. Frank stated he had sawhorses, which could be used for barricades. Commissioner Pfeifer stated in the past most people parked between Pecan Lane and Driftwood Lane. He added some people even parked on Pine Lane and Cypress Lane. Commissioner Phipps then made a motion to close Lakeview Drive to westbound traffic as discussed. Commissioner Pfeifer seconded the motion, which carried.
5. **OPEN DISCUSSION:** Mayor Pickens noted plans for the water tower are at TNRCC. Their thirty days to approve is just about up. The City Council has set May 4<sup>th</sup> as the date for the annual City Wide Clean Up. BFI will provide extra trucks for large items on that day. He added we need to notify residents of items not included in clean up such as tires and

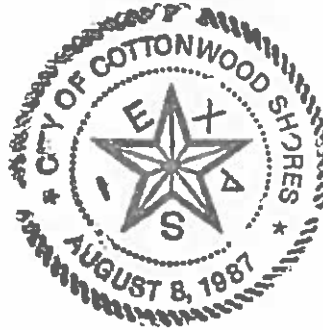
