Agenda #1. Minutes from the August 24th 1989 meeting were read. Mike Butler made a motion to accept as read. Adrian Gawlik 2nd the motion. Motion was carried.

Agenda #2. The financial report and bills paid were read for the month of August 1989. Mike Butler made a motion to approve as read. Adrian Gawlik 2nd the motion. Motion was carried.

Agenda #3. Ordinance No.92889-1A amending Ordinance No. 042888-1A was read and approved as read at the Public Hearing prior to the Regular City Meeting.

Agenda #4. The discussion with a L.C.R.A. representative was tabled.

Agenda #5. Action on the purchase of Cotton-Terrace Water System was tabled til the City books are audited.

Agenda #6. The Cottonwood Shores Volunteer Fire Department reported that there was a show of support from the community and that a Fire Fry would be November 4th, 1989 to raise funds. It was suggested that we pass word on the no burning ordinance the City of Cottonwood Shores has as well as the county having passed a no burning county wide due to the severe drought we are having. There was a discussion on a new phone in to elderly persons called R.U.O.K. by Marble Falls. Leon Upshaw was quite interested in seeing if a program such as this could be implemented here in Cottonwood Shores.

Agenda #7. A motion was made by Mike Butler to purchase an adding machine for the City of Cottonwood Shores not to exceed \$40.00. Adrain Gawlik 2nd the motion. Motion was carried.

Agenda #8. Leon Upshaw will contact Ron Tommelson of the City of Marble Falls on what ordinance would be need to enforce the cleanup of trash from property in Cottonwood Shores.

Agenda \$9. Leon Upshaw read a letter from G.T.E. on the new dialing within our area code to include the dialing of 512 after September 9. 1990.

Agenda #10. Leon Uphsaw ~~will~~ will contact Ron Tommelson on building permit and code ordinance when he sees him on the trash ordinance.

Tony Satsky agreed to help in being the inspector for the City of Cottonwood Shores building codes that would be adopted as an ordinance.


