The City of Cottonwood Shores Commissioners convened in a City meeting September 4, 1990 at 7.00 p.m.. Those present were Leon Upshaw; Mayor, Adrian Gawlik; Commissioner 1, and Mike Butler; Commissioner 11.

Agenda #1. Steve Davis, District Manager for G.T.E. presented the commissioners with copies of the Franchise Ordinance. It was brought to the commissioners attention Section #6 in that a minimum of 2% ~~and~~ no more ~~than~~ 6% can be charged. Most cities collect 2%. The Franchise is collected from the customer to the city. There is also a minimum of 5 years on the agreement. It will take 60 days for the signed Ordinance to be signed by G.T.E. One of the agreements will stay with the city and three will go to G.T.E. It was decided to place the Ordinance on the September 27th, 1990 meeting.
