

The City of Cottonwood Shores Commissioners convened in a Regular City Meeting May 16, 1991 at 8.00 p.m. at the city hall located at 3915 Cottonwood Drive. Those present were Joseph Beyer, Mayor; Adrian Gawlik, Commissioner 1 and Mike Butler, Commissioner 11.

1. Minutes from the April 18th, 1991 meeting were read. Adrian Gawlik motioned they be approved as read. Mike Butler 2nd the motion. Motion was carried. Minutes from the May 9th, 1991 meeting canvassing the election were read. Mike motion they be approved as read. Adrian Gawlik 2nd the motion. Motion was carried.

2. The financial report and bills paid for the month of April 1991 were read from the day sheets. Adrian Gawlik motioned that the report be accepted as corrected. Mike Butler 2nd the motion. Motion was carried.

3. Discussion on Zoning and Building Ordinances led to the necessity to clarify the city and P.O.A. responsibilities with regards to roads. It was suggested that we have public hearings on the Zoning and Building codes for citizen input. It was also suggested to have a uniform code for the entire city in regards to a building code. Any action on the Zoning and Building Ordinances was tabled until further notice.


4. It was motioned by Mike Butler to advertise in the newspaper the cities solicitation on bids for garbage pick up for the City of Cottonwood Shores. Adrian Gawlik 2nd the motion. Motion was carried.


5. Tim Doyal, Animal Control Officer, contacted L.C.R.A. on the possibility of placing a animal pound near the lake. It was noted that this was not a feasible idea due to the cleaning of the facility and the runoff going into the lake as well as times of flooding. Tony Hogue, Mayor of Marble Falls, told Tim that they would be expanding their shelter to hold more animals and that there was possibility of Marble Falls working with area communities for housing of animals. The time for expected completion is approximately 6 months. It was noted that the purchase of a rope pole for Tim Doyal to perform his duties cost between \$80.00 - \$100.00. Duties of the Animal Control Officer will be to quarantine animals at owners expense and the capture and delivery of untagged animals to a facility for adoption or elimination. Mike Butler officially appointed Tim Doyal as Animal Control Officer for the City of Cottonwood Shores. Adrian Gawlik 2nd the motion. Motion was carried.

6. Joseph Beyer brought to the Commissioners attention the need to purchase insurance for property, personal liability and workman's compensation for the city. It was also noted that an ordinance addressing plumbing codes would need to be drafted to be in compliance with the Texas Water Commission with regards to the city water. The P.O.A. has approximately \$6,000 for road repair this year and that the city needs to look at helping with the financial end of the road repair necessary with this years budget. It was also suggested that the county be contacted to see what help could be offered with equipment for the roads of Cottonwood Shores.

Mike Butler moved that the meeting be adjourned.
