SPECIAL MEETING
of the City Commission
March 26, 1992
7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Joseph Beyer at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall located at 3915 Cottonwood Drive, Cottonwood Shores, Texas. Commissioners Adrian Gawlik and Mike Butler were in attendance.

Mayor Beyer read an Affidavit filed by both Commissioners to allow them to vote on the re-zoning request even though they have an economic interest in the change.

Commissioner Gawlik stated that regardless of whether he lived 200' or farther he would vote the same way. He added that he was not prejudiced and if it would benefit the City he would vote for the re-zoning.

Commissioner Butler made a motion to approve the re-zoning request. There was no second. Motion died.

Commissioner Gawlik made a motion to reject the request for re-zoning. Commissioner Butler seconded the motion. Mayor Beyer commented that he would like to see property values go up. He felt there would be a deterioration of property values if more Commercial property were to be allowed in the City. Mayor Beyer then called for a vote. All members of the Commission present voted "Aye" in favor of rejecting the request for re-zoning. Motion carried.

Mayor Beyer explained that as a City we are not required to operate under a Texas Water Commission Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. He added that the Certificate provides some additional protection for areas served outside the City.

Commissioner Butler made a motion to cancel the CCN. Commissioner Gawlik seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mayor Beyer advised that in the next billing for water and garbage we have to notify all customers of the cancellation of the CCN.


Commissioner Gawlik made a motion to adjourn.
