MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING PROPOSED FY 1998-1999 BUDGET CITY COUNCIL - CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES SEPTEMBER 10, 1998

- 1. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:03 P.M. AND A QUORUM WAS PRESENT WITH COMMISSIONERS FRANK PFEIFER AND RAY WHITIS.
- 2. THE MAYOR COMPLIMENTED THE COMMISSIONERS ON THEIR HARD WORK AT NUMEROUS BUDGET WORKSHOPS AND HOURS OF WORK RESULTING IN THE CITY GOVERNMENT PUTTING TOGETHER A PROPOSED FY 1998-1999 BUDGET. PROPOSED REVENUES AND EXPENSES, FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE CITY'S HISTORY, EXCEED A HALF-MILLION DOLLARS A VIABLE SIGN OF THE FUTURE GROWTH ALREADY UNDERWAY THIS YEAR. IN MOST CASES WHERE THE COUNCIL SAW A NEED FOR INCREASED EXPENDITURES, IT WAS FOR VISIBLE IMPROVEMENTS: SALARIES, THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ROAD MATERIALS. DECREASES IN EXPENDITURES FELL INTO SUCH AREAS AS THE EXPENSE OF THE ANNUAL AUDIT, TRAVEL EXPENSES AND CHEMICAL COSTS. THE COUNCIL ADDED A DONATION TO THE CRISIS CENTER, AN AGENCY WHICH CONTINUES TO SERVE PEOPLE IN OUR AREA AND HAS BEEN USED EXTENSIVELY THIS YEAR....EXPANSION TO ACCOMMODATE MORE "SAFEHOUSING" IS PLANNED TO ENHANCE THE OPERATION.

THE COUNCIL ALSO DISCUSSED THE PENDING ORDINANCE CONTAINING BUDGET AMENDMENTS FOR FY 1997-1998 WHICH WILL BE PRESENTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING SEPTEMBER 17, 1998.

- 3. THE MAYOR THEN READ ORDINANCE 091098. COMMISSIONER FRANK PFEIFER MOVED TO APPROVE THE ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 1998-1999 BUDGET AS PRESENTED. COMMISSIONER RAY WHITIS SECONDED THE MOTION, WHICH CARRIED ON VOTE.
- 4. OPEN DISCUSSION, NONE.

ORDINANCE NO. 091098

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1998 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1999, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS FOR GENERAL LAW CITIES, THE BUDGET COVERING THE PROPOSED EXPENDITURES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1998 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1999 WAS FILED WITH THE CITY SECRETARY AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON SAME WAS PROVIDED AS REQUIRED; AND

WHEREAS, A PUBLIC HEARING WAS DULY HELD AT THE TIME AND PLACE PROVIDED FOR IN SUCH NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND ALL INTERESTED PERSONS WERE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD ON SAID BUDGET; AND

WHEREAS, IT IS NECESSARY, AT THIS TIME, THAT SAID BUDGET BE ADOPTED;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES. TEXAS. AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. THAT THE BUDGET PRESENTED BY THE CITY ADMINISTRATION AND REVIEWED DURING THE PUBLIC HEARING IS HEREBY APPROVED AND ADOPTED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1998-1999.

SECTION 2. THAT THE CITY ADMINISTRATION IS AUTHORIZED TO INVEST ANY FUNDS NOT NEEDED FOR CURRENT USE, WHETHER OPERATING FUNDS OR BOND FUNDS, IN UNITED STATES TREASURY BILLS, SAVINGS ACCOUNTS OR CERTIFICATES OF DEPOSIT IN THE CITY DEPOSITORY. INTEREST ACCRUED FROM SUCH INVESTMENT(S) MAY BE DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL FUND. ALL OF WHICH INVESTMENTS SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW.

SECTION 3. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE.
