g) CONSIDER AND POSSIBLY TAKE ACTION ON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO GET BIDS ON THE APPRAISAL FOR THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS BWD FOR THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES.
