  - 6.3. Police Department Report read by Mayor Breen. Councilmember Orr quoted the citation numbers are unacceptable, change is needed, and the six month trial is not working.

- Citizen Comments: This is the opportunity for visitors and quests to address the City 7.1. Council on any issue. City Council may not discuss any presented issue, nor may any action be taken on any issue at this time. (Attorney General Opinion – Jc-0169)
  - > Citizen Bob Hughes resides at 3731 Lakeview Dr. reported a drainage problem. He would like to see corrected when rainwater from Westwood washes down towards his garage. There is a ditch across street on south side which is clogged, and there is a drain running to other ditch on the south east side to connect to ditch running down along boat ramp road.
  - > Citizen Marley Porter resides at 4113 Lakeview Dr. remarked for sustainability reasons would be to allow smaller lots perhaps 50X50 and allow an 800 square foot home with 2 bedrooms and 1 bath. This could allow families places they can afford.
  - Citizen Shelley Demarest resides at 756 Pecan quoted there are people who do not want this. They want yards for their children to play in safely. They do not want neighbor houses so near and close to each other, and the same style.
  - > Citizen Raul Garcia resides at 826 Aspen Lane reported he turned in a paper over a year ago concerning the traffic on 2147. Especially the wide intersection coming in to CWS. There have been so many close calls from accidents. Citizen Garcia said he also complained about the rental business with parking their equipment too close to 2147 road blocking drivers view.
  - Citizen Chris Stein resides at 840 Cypress reports he would rather have the yard space for kids to play, and be safe.
  - > Citizen Raul Garcia agreed.
  - > Citizen Kim Taylor resides at 752 Pecan agreed, because she has a small yard.
- 8. Presentation: Marley Porter presentation and review on Development Plan for CastleRock Phase II, and CastleRock Lakeside.
  - Mr. Porter placed map description on wall. He began explaining the 3 phases of construction for CastleRock, Lake CastleRock, and New Lakes. 

### Council Members:

In preparing to enter the sales tax revenue, it has come to my attention that Jerrial has placed the sales tax in the Utilities revenue for the months of November 2007, December 2007, and January 2008. This didn't make sense, and checked with Dan Painter to verify that there hadn't been a reason for it. He concurred that the money should have gone into the General fund, not Utilities.

### Personnel Issues:

9.6.3.

Discuss and consider action to solicit applications for employment of a fulltime Public Works Working Supervisor who will also perform the functions of the City Inspector as requested by CA Schneider.

### Background:

- One Public Works employee is going on 3-month medical leave of absence effective 3/24/08 leaving us with 1 Water Plant Operator and 1 PW Maintenance Technician.
  - a. City facilities and streets are in a sad state of repair.
  - b. Animal Control requirements are unpredictable and time-consuming.
  - c. Summer mowing needs, street and facility maintenance needs exceed the capacity of 1.0 1.5 persons.
  - d. This staffing leaves no margin for absenteeism due to illness, vacations, etc.
- 2. The present subcontracting of City Inspection services is unsatisfactory in availability, quality and timing.
- City records, drawings, specifications, etc. all are currently mostly inaccessible (or non-existent) and need to be organized to be useful when needed.
- 4. A maintenance schedule is needed to utilize resources most effectively and begin to catch up with past neglect.

### Recommendation:

Employ a hands-on PW Supervisor to complement the present 1.0 – 1.5 person resource and take on full-time responsibility for the above cited tasks while participating in "getting the work done" when/as time is available.

I recommend imposing on the new employee the requirement to obtain the certifications necessary for the performance as City Inspector within 2 years from the date of hire.

### Background:

The City has 1 "B" Surface Water-licensed Water Plant Operator and 1 Public Works employee who may obtain his "D" license soon.

All license levels below B require the supervision of a B-licensed Operator.

A second D-licensed PW employee is going on 3 months of medical leave.

In the event that our B-licensed Operator becomes unavailable to unforeseeable causes the city would have to "hunt" for a qualified supervisor to fill in.

### Recommendation:

Hire an at least C-licensed Operator with the aim of his obtaining a B license within 1-2 years of his date of hire to support our water plant operations, improvements (ORCA STEP) and future expansions necessary to meet the City's growth projections.

Discuss and consider action to change personnel policy to offer standard City benefits including Group Health Insurance to part time employees on a basis prorated to their scheduled work hours as requested by CA Schneider.

### Background:

This subject came to the fore when

- a. the full-time Utility Billing Clerk requested reduced work hours (25 hrs/wk) after the hiring and training of a person originally intended as backup (due to frequent absenteeism). The intent was to remain employed to retain insurance coverage.
- b. I, Interim City Administrator, was employed for 32 hrs/week and receive Group Health Insurance coverage.
- 1. Present CWS Personnel Policy provides Group Health Insurance coverage
  - ONLY to "full-time" employees.
  - Full-time employment is defined as 40 scheduled hours of work per week.
- 2. TML, the City's health insurance contractor requires that
  - · ALL employees who receive standard benefits and
  - Are schedule to work at least 20 hours per week MUST participate in the Group Plan.
- 3. CWS is not competitive with the terms of employment and benefits offered by surrounding communities making it difficult to recruit the skilled employees needed for the projected future growth of the City.
- 4. Wages offered to part-time employees generally do not support a monthly deduction of \$391.00 for Health coverage.

### Recommendation:

Grant ALL employees who are scheduled for at least 20 hours/wk the standard benefits defined in the Personnel Policy proportional to their SCHEDULED WORK HOURS.

Part-time employees who are scheduled for less than 20 hours/wk are ineligible.

Increased costs to the City would be very nominal.

100% of benefits will be earned by full-time employees (40 hrs/wk).

- All others earn the same benefits, except Group Health Insurance coverage, but reduced to the percentage equivalent to their scheduled work hours to 100%.
- Since Group Health Insurance coverage under these conditions is mandatory (TML) part-time employees scheduled for more than 20 hrs/week would be required to share the cost of this coverage by paying the difference between the City's contribution and the actual cost.
- Example: 100% of cost is \$391.00/mo. A 20 hr/wk employee pays 50% of this cost by payroll deduction, i.e. \$195.50/mo, The City pays the other 50%.
