- 7.3. **Discussed adopting an updated version of the International Building Codes.** *As requested by Staff*

Mayor Orr opened the discussion regarding the building codes, stating we currently are utilizing the 2006 codes. He commented that a lot of cities are using up to the 2015 version and the cost for building a home could be around a 5-6% increase. He requested comments from the City Council. Councilmember Thomas stated we should go to the 2015; Councilmember Hibdon commented we should go to the 2105; Mayor Pro Tem Trinidad questioned if there would be additional costs to meet the new code on the remodel of a home. This was to be addressed to ATS Engineers. Mayor Orr requested this to be placed on the next meeting agenda.

- 8.1. **Discussed and considered action** on the Parks and Recreation Committee in regard to FY2018 and FY2019 Plans and Budget. *As requested by Staff*

Mayor Orr opened the item by presenting the Parks current budget and their plans for a 2-year projection as proposed last year at this time. It was stated they have not accomplished all of their proposals or used any of their budget funds. He reiterated that the budget would not be carried over if not spent by end of the fiscal year. Within the list was a possible irrigation system at Aspen Park along with other items at estimated costs, no actual bids. The City Council agreed that the Parks Committee needed to bring a budget with actual bid estimates and documentation to the Council.

8.4. Discussed the status of the construction contract for TWDB/CDBG Water Plant Project. *As requested by Staff*

Mayor Orr gave the City Council the status of the construction at the water plant. He stated that the bids all came in higher than the budget and that the City and Steve Kallman were working with the lowest bidder to try and get costs down.

He commented on the need to modify some of the vendor requirements, locations of non-critical items, possible change in basic structure.

He is working to put together the data and bring it back to the City Council. The bidding contractor is out of Spicewood.

One item to possibly change was the Pall micro filtration system version. Pall offered the AP4 unit for \$75,000.00 less than the original bid.

The process requires the plans to be redrawn, a new bid from the contractor and then sent to TCEQ to reapprove.

Mayor Orr will keep the City Council updated.

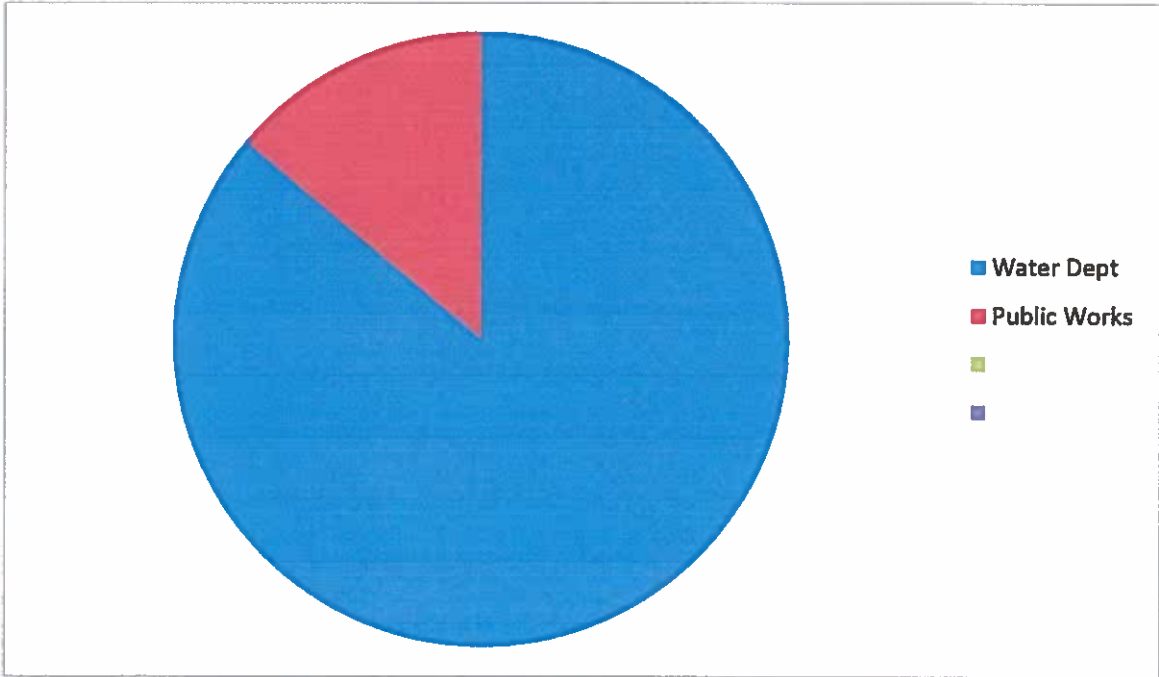
