Mayor Orr reviewed the discussion from the last meeting. He had researched and found that when a home is remodeled, construction would fall under the IEBC codes, not the IBC codes. The IEBC codes are completely different. The Council needs to review and discuss at a later meeting.

9. New Business

9.1. Discussed and considered action on request to revoke Ordinance 3016 (Residential Rental Property Inspections). *As requested by Barbara Lee*

Barbara Lee presented her concerns and reasons why she felt the Ordinance should be revoked or at least reworked. She said she had a petition signed by most of her renters stating their opposition to the ordinance. She felt the Ordinance was biased toward rental properties and was unfair to landlords and renters. She said there were federal and state laws that take care of renters. Council informed her that the City can enact stricter laws than state or federal laws, but they cannot enact less strict laws. Ms. Lee also felt it would be an unfair expense and time burden for the landlords if they had to purchase fire extinguishers for each rental property and track the fire extinguishers date info. She also didn't feel that the City's Code enforcement official would have time to do inspections in a timely manner, causing her more loss of income.

Council reminded her that they have to protect all the residences of this City. The Ordinance was to protect them and the rental registration and inspections were the only way they could do that. Ms. Lee requested that the Council not make a decision at this time, but think about it some more and make a decision at a later date. She also said that she had a list of solutions but forgot to bring it. She would send to Council via email.

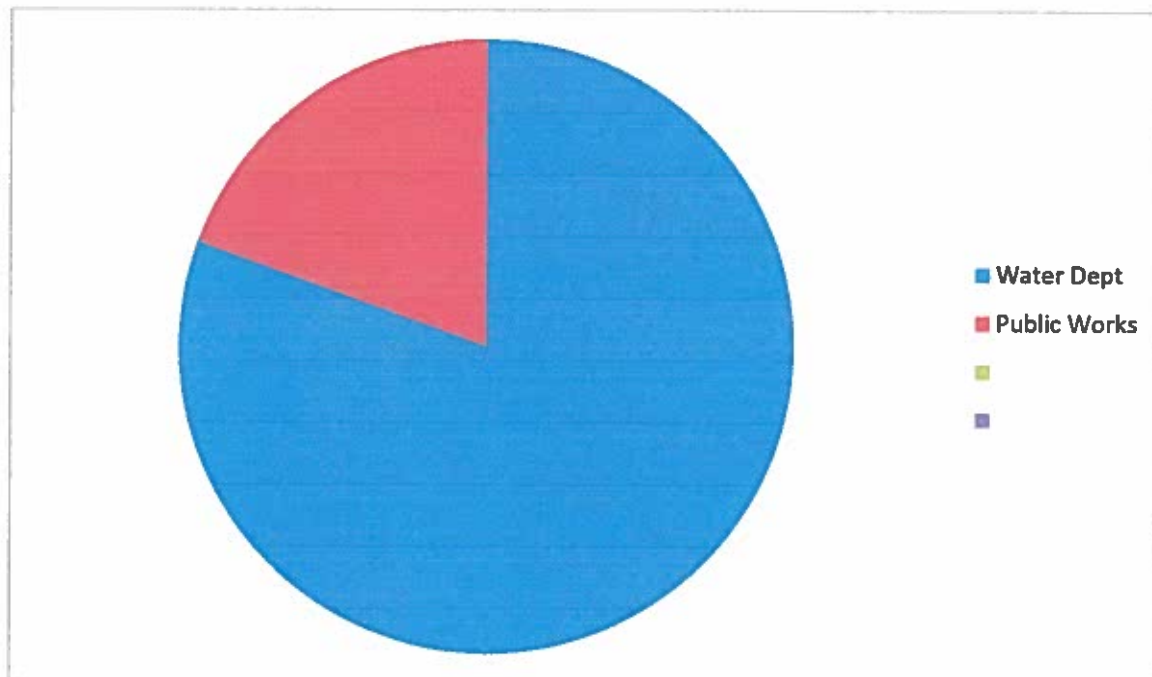
