WHEREAS, people of all ages from all walks of life, must be made aware of their personal responsibility in helping people keep themselves, their families, and their communities safe from crime;


WHEREAS, the personal injury, financial loss, and community deterioration resulting from crime are intolerable and require investment from the whole community to eradicate;

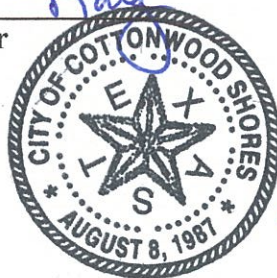
