- NO Agricultural pesticides/chemicals
- NO Appliances
- No Compact Florescent Bulbs (take to Home Depot)
- No Containers Larger than 5 Gallons
- NO Explosives
- NO Medical and Pharmaceutical Items
- NO Large propane cylinders over 30 lbs.
- NO Wooden Consoles (for older TV's)
- NO Industrial or Commercial/Business Waste

#### **Safety Guidelines**

- Bring products in original containers only.
- Do not mix or consolidate products.
- Properly seal containers to prevent leaking.
- Haul containers and materials in the trunk or back of vehicle, away from passengers.
