

ORDINANCE 1015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS; DECLARING THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES FOR COUNCIL POSITION NOS. 1, 3 AND 5 ELECTED; PROVIDING THAT THE MAY 12, 2012, GENERAL MUNICIPAL OFFICERS ELECTION SHALL NOT BE HELD; CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Cottonwood Shores, Texas (the "City"), passed and approved Ordinance No. 1004 on February 16, 2012, for the purpose of electing three (3) officials of the City, to wit: Council Position No. 1, Council Position No. 3 and Council Position No. 5.

Section 2. Pursuant to said Ordinance No. 1004 and Section 141.007 of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE, the deadline for filing applications for a place on the ballot of the City's municipal officers election has expired and the deadline for filing as a write-in candidate has also expired.

Section 3. The City Secretary, in accordance with Section 2.052, TEXAS ELECTION CODE, has certified to the City Council in writing that Travis Hockensmith is unopposed for election to the office of Council Position No. 1, Mary Ann Houser is unopposed for election to the office of Council Position No. 3, and Roger Wayson is unopposed for election to the office of Council Position No. 5.

Section 4. The City Council hereby finds and determines that each candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot in said election is unopposed, and no proposition is to appear on the ballot for such election.

Section 5. In accordance with Section 2.053(a), TEXAS ELECTION CODE, the following unopposed candidates are hereby declared duly elected to the respective offices shown:

Council Position No. 1 -	Travis Hockensmith
Council Position No. 3 -	Mary Ann Houser
Council Position No. 5 -	Roger Wayson

Section 6. Pursuant to Section 2.053(b), TEXAS ELECTION CODE, the general municipal officers election heretofore called and ordered by City of Cottonwood Shores, Texas, Ordinance No. 1015 for the 12th day of May, 2012, shall not be held and is hereby cancelled.


Section 7. The City Secretary is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Ordinance to be posted on election day, same being May 12, 2012, at the polling place that would have been used in such election.

Section 8. In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Cottonwood Shores, Texas,

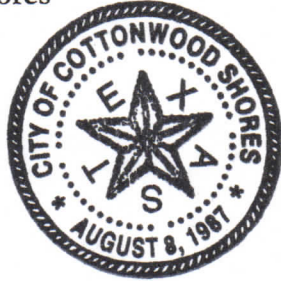
declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one of more parts.

Section 9. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.
