Ordinance 1104

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DRILLING AND MINING OR THE REOPENING OF ANY ABANDONED WELL OR MINE IN ANY PUBLIC PARK LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS**

**History:**

July 19, 2012: Repealed Ordinance 226 and replaced with Ordinance 1104

**WHEREAS,** the City of Cottonwood Shores desires to protect all park property within the city limits from actions that would cause environmental damage or otherwise devalue the property;

**WHEREAS,** the City of Cottonwood Shores desires to maintain park property in perpetuity in a manner which optimizes enjoyment by the community;


**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, THAT;**

**SECTION 1:** All forms of drilling and mining are permanently prohibited in any public park located within the city limits of the City of Cottonwood Shores, Texas

**SECTION 2:** No previously drilled and abandoned mine or well may be reopened in any park located within the city limits of the City of Cottonwood Shores, Texas

**SECTION 3:** City Council hereby finds and declares that the adoption, passage, and implementation of this ordinance shall be effective as of the first reading

**PASSED AND APPROVED** by the City Council of Cottonwood Shores, Texas, at a meeting on the 19th day of July, 2012 with 5 votes in favor, 0 votes against, and 0 abstentions.
