ORDINANCE 11070

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2005 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2006, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas for General Law Cities, the budget covering the proposed expenditures for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2005 and ending September 30, 2006 was filed with the City Secretary and notice of Public Hearing on same was provided as required; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was duly held at the time and place provided for in such notice of Public Hearing and all interested persons were given the opportunity to be heard on said budget; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary at this time that the said budget be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the budget presented by the City Council and reviewed during the Public Hearings is hereby approved and adopted for the Fiscal Year 2005-2006.

SECTION 2. That the City Council is authorized to invest any funds not needed for current use, whether Operating Funds or Bond Funds, in United States Treasury Bills, Savings Accounts or Certificates of Deposit in the City Depository. Interest accrued from such investment(s) may be deposited in the General Fund. All investments shall be in accordance with the law.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

ORIGINAL ORDINANCE PASSED THIS 15TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2005, AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE REGULAR MEETING SCHEDULED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS, THERE BEING A QUORUM PRESENT, BY FIVE (5) YEAS AND ZERO (0) NAYS, AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON THIS DATE SET FORTH.
