**RESOLUTION 673**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS, CEASING OPERATION OF PATSCHKE SPRINGS, CASTLEROCK AND THE BOAT RAMP AS PUBLIC CITY PARKS AND REPEALING ANY PRIOR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN THIS RESOLUTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Cottonwood Shores (Council), on November 5, 2009 dedicated Patschke Springs and Castlerock as City Parks in fulfillment of the requirements of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department's Grant 50-000404 to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Cottonwood Shores (Council), on May 13, 2010 declared and dedicated the Boat Ramp as Parkland in the City; and

**WHEREAS**, On July 14, 2014, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department's final review of Grant 50-000404 affirmed that funds from the Grant were not applied to these three parks which would allow the Grant to be amended and the three parks be absolved from the Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the expense of bringing all City Parks into ADA compliance is prohibitive and the Council has determined to focus on bringing only Community Park, Aspen Park and the Nature Preserve into ADA compliance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS:**

Patschke Springs, Castlerock and the Boat Ramp will be closed as City Parks effective with the signing of this Resolution.

**PASSED THIS THE 7th DAY OF AUGUST 2014, AT A MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS, THERE BEING A QUORUM PRESENT, BY 3 YEAS, 2 NAYS AND 0 ABSTAINS.**
