A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING THE STATE FIRE MARSHALL AS THE FIRE MARSHALL FOR THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Cottonwood Shores City Council desires to safeguard life, health, property, and public welfare; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cottonwood Shores desires to administer and enforce applicable provisions of the Insurance Code and other law relating to fire control; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cottonwood Shores may require assistance in studies of fires causing damage to property or injuries, fire protection, research to improve fire protection, and inspection of certain buildings; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Burnet, Texas does not have a position of Fire Marshall,

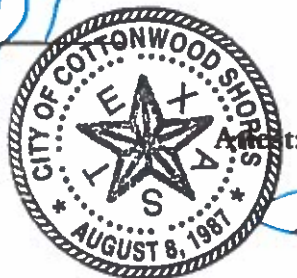
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF COTTONWOOD SHORES, TEXAS:

The City of Cottonwood Shores, Texas, in the County of Burnet, establishes the State Fire Marshall of Texas to provide such services for the City.
